The PLCI website has a wealth of information, including:

- **Assessments** of Pacific Lamprey habitat conditions, population demographics, distribution, and threats including California.
- Description of "Regional Management Units" (RMUs) for the purpose of implementing conservation actions in different regions – including different parts of California.
- **Regional Implementation Plans** that identify, prioritize, and implement key conservation actions with the goal of restoring Pacific Lamprey.
